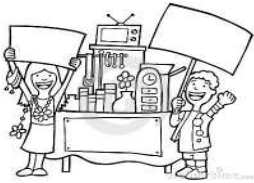

Mothers Day

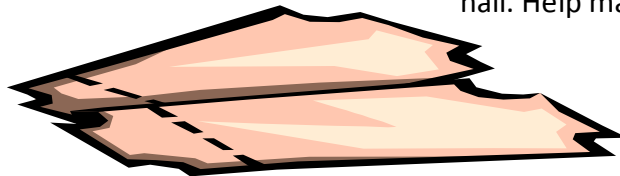
