From our President: Relocation Update

After many months of working with the Town of Erwin for approval of our site plan, it looks like final approval will come on September 9th. After that date we will finalize the purchase of the property. The house on the new site will be prepared for the new rectory, and the existing rectory will be placed on the market for sale.

Construction documents will begin soon. We are in discussion with an experienced Clerk-of-the-Works, which is someone who will work as our agent to manage the construction project. This will save us tens of thousands of dollars that a general contractor would typically charge for that management.

Father Dan has been in contact with our Bishop to arrange a ground blessing. We hope to break ground in mid to late October. This will allow the builder to get the shell of the building up prior to winter weather and work through the cold months on the interior. If that occurs, then occupancy could be as early as March of 2016.

As the final design of the building nears, a kitchen design will be needed. I have asked the president of the Altar Society to gather representatives to work with a professional commercial kitchen designer. There are many ideas that have been kicked around, and starting with a blank slate should yield a wonderful workspace for kitchen activities.

Recently a stain glass window expert from Rochester visited to look at the windows in our church. The windows can definitely be removed safely and relocated. The windows will be used in the new church, but not in the exterior walls due to the construction and condition of the windows. We will relocate as many items as practical from the existing church to the new church. There will be a list of new items that will be available to be donated for the new church once the final design is complete.

Recently we received a purchase offer on our existing buildings on Sunset Drive. This was completely out of the blue, as we have not started marketing the property. An agent heard of our plan to move and had a client that needs buildings such as ours. We are still negotiating the terms, and if all goes well we will have a contract. The buyer is looking for occupancy in April, which coincides with our timetable to move into the new facility.

As always, your input is encouraged. The building site is beautiful and will provide a wonderful place to worship and grow for generations to come.

Church Funerals are provided for practicing Orthodox Christians who are current in their Spiritual and Financial obligations to the parish otherwise burial is from the funeral home.

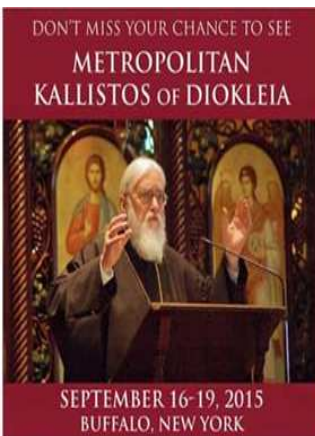
